Canada Soccer is committed to ensuring that all players are supervised by appropriately educated and licensed coaches. In addition to Canada Soccer's coach education pathway, the Membership Player Levy funds also support programs to increase the number of women in coaching such as TELUS SheCanCoach and AccelerateHER.

Canada Soccer Safe Sport Roster

Canada Soccer's Safe Sport Roster is a comprehensive framework of policies and programs designed to ensure a safe, inclusive, and high-quality soccer experience for all participants across Canada. Rooted in the Universal Code of Conduct to Prevent and Address Maltreatment in Sport (UCCMS), the Safe Sport Roster enforces strict standards for player safety, coach education, and club accountability. Key initiatives include mandatory adherence to the Canada Soccer Youth Club Licensing Program, background screening, ethical coaching training, concussion protocols, and accessible reporting mechanisms for misconduct. By implementing these measures, Canada Soccer fosters a respectful and supportive environment, promoting the physical, mental, and emotional well-being of all players.

ENCOURAGE AND OVERSEE GROWTH

Canada Soccer is committed to fostering the growth of the game at all levels by providing resources, programs, and opportunities that make soccer more accessible and inclusive across the country.

Through various initiatives we strive to create welcoming environments for players of all backgrounds. By working with our members and partners, we continue to strengthen the foundation of the sport and inspire the next generation of players.
