Canada Soccer's Futsal Canadian Championship will deliver the highest level of national competition for futsal players and organisations across the country. The 2025 edition will be played in Regina, Saskatchewan from 10 to 13 April with 16 teams for men and women qualifying to the Futsal Canadian Championship.



Technical / Spectator Areas


Only accredited staff and players are permitted in the technical area. Please refer to the facility map to view specific areas for spectators.

COMPETITION MEETINGS

To help prepare for Canada Soccer's Futsal Canadian Championship, the following virtual and in-person meetings have been planned.

The Canada Soccer Match Commissioner and General Coordinator will chair the Pre-Competition Meeting. The Provincial/Territorial Rep and a team representative must attend the pre-competition meeting. All teams must bring a sample of their team and keeper uniforms to this meeting, including all colours and all keeper uniforms.

Pre-Arrival Meeting for Participating Clubs

Canada Soccer will coordinate a virtual (Zoom) pre-arrival meeting with all the Participating Clubs in March. Club Participation in one of these two meetings is mandatory.
