### The Opportunity

This unique dual-role involves coaching the **Vogel Cup (Men’s Over 45)** national team and managing the **Carlitos Cup (Over 60 Mixed)** squad—an exciting, collaborative joint-nation team combining players from Canada, Costa Rica, and Colombia.

This is an exceptional opportunity for an **early-to-mid-career coach** looking to gain international tournament experience, manage high-performance master athletes (all practicing physicians), and build a footprint within a growing global sporting community. Successful performance may lead to future opportunities within the TCMF national program.

### Key Responsibilities

- **Tactical Leadership:** Elite-level game management, tactical preparation, and squad rotation for tournament play in high-temperature conditions.
- **Joint-Nation Collaboration:** Cultivating chemistry and communication for the joint Carlitos Cup team, blending cultures and playing styles seamlessly.
- **Player Management:** Managing tournament load, recovery, and team culture for master-level athletic professionals.
- **Training Camp:** Leading the tactical and physical preparation at the mandatory selection and training camp in **Toronto, ON (October 2–4, 2026)**.
